

The Alexander Academy Difference

BC Dogwood Graduation Program

Students at Alexander Academy complete the BC Dogwood Graduation Program.

The BC Certificate of Graduation or "Dogwood Diploma" is awarded to students who successfully complete the provincial graduation requirements. In order to graduate, students must pass specific courses.

Overall, each student must acquire 80 credits from a combination of required courses, elective courses, and the Graduation Transitions Program.



University Transfer Program (Dual Credits)

At Alexander Academy, our students are at the center of the learning process and become members of our extended educational community through our unique University Transfer Program.

Senior students with strong academic standing may expand their educational portfolio by enrolling at Alexander College as concurrent studies students, allowing them to complete university transfer courses and receive dual credits while still attending Alexander Academy.





English Language Development Program

To support our diverse community, Alexander Academy provides a comprehensive English Language Development Program (ELDP).

The ELD program allows our international students to advance their English language skills within our preparatory program offerings.

Our inclusive and comprehensive language development programs support the acquisition of English for students whose first language is not English.

Leadership and Community Service

Our Leadership and Service Program allows students to recognize they have a responsibility to help others. We aim to foster a love of service in each student.

By graduation, students will have developed and implemented individual leadership initiatives in the school and local community.
